 - -J. Sheese overviewed the revised student handbook.
 - -Discussed the following:
 - After a minimum of 10 weeks of placement, students can do substitute teaching outside their content area.
 - Communications is needed when student teachers do not feel comfortable with being assigned to a classroom to teach outside their content area.
 - Need to specify not only the name of an assigned school but also the teaching place for their licensable content area, their host teacher, their area of coaching
