

Are you interested in staying overnight on-campus during your student's orientation program? Read below for some quick facts about staying overnight!

- You will be staying in Pickerl Hall (private bathrooms). View the floor plan [here](#).
- \$40 fee per room each night, up to two nights. No reduced rates for multiple rooms.
- 2 extra-long twin beds per room. A maximum of two adults and two children under the age of 12 per room. If bringing children to sleep on the floor, you must provide sleeping bags or linens for the children. Children under the age of 16 cannot stay in a room unaccompanied by a parent/guardian.
- Students attending State Orientation cannot stay with their families in Pickerl the night of their program for safety reasons.
- Sheets, light blanket, pillow, towels, microwave, and a refrigerator will be available in each room
 - Guests can rent additional linen sets for children at \$5 per kit at the front desk.
- Does not include: A television in the room. A television is available in the lounge area.

 - If you would like to pay via cash or check you may request a room on the morning of the program during check-in
- Check-in to the hall will begin at 5:00 p.m. Day One of your program (please leave your luggage in your vehicle until that time) and check-out will occur before 9:00 a.m. the next day.
- Did you forget to make a reservation? Don't worry, you can let us know the morning of the program!
- Be sure to make arrangements for dinner that night! There **will not be on-campus dining options available**. Your student will eat dinner as part of their orientation program. Maps of downtown Terre Haute will be available at the Pickerl Hall desk.
