Parking and Traffic Committee Summary

The committee had two meetings. December 5, 2017 and February 21, 2018

The items discussed include:

Speed Limits in the parking garage and on campus streets. Individuals had reported occurrences
of speeding in the garage making pedestrians feel unsafe. It was recommended that the current
speed limit of 5 miles an hour be maintained. Emails were sent out to all garage permit holders
to remind them of the speed limit and the need for caution while driving in the garage. It was
decided that email reminders would be sent out each quarter.

The committee felt that campus street speed limits were adequate.

- Permit use during events in the parking garage. Individuals had reported that they didn't want
 to pay the \$5 event fee when entering the garage during events if they had a permit. The
 committee felt that the event fees should be charged during all events after normal business
 hours.
- Free or discounted Part-time/Adjunct Faculty permits were discussed. The committee decided
 that there were multiple reduced cost permit options available to meet this need. A
 recommendation was made to the VP McKee, to not make any changes to the current parking
 regulations.
