The College of Graduate and Professional studies does not require that your thesis or dissertation is bound. However, students may wish to bind their approved documents. In an effort to assist students, the following is a list of available binding services that require only a PDF. Please that note the cost and quality of these services may vary and ISU does not endorse any single service provider.

ProQuest. ProQuest provides a double sided binding option as part of the official electronic submission process. Please note ProQuest binds double sided only.*

Ph.D. Book Binding. This service provides single and double sided binding options.
