Athletic Training, M.S.

The University offers a professional master of science (M.S.) in athletic training. This program prepares students for the Board of Certification examination to earn the credential as a Certified Athletic Trainer.

Students in the program will be well-prepared to practice at the top of their license through experiences with simulated patient encounters and clinical rotations under the supervision of forward-thinking athletic trainers in the high school, collegiate, and professional sports settings.

Total tuition cost, based on 2020-2021 graduate tuition rates:

In-State: \$23,004, Interstate/Midwest: \$29,916, Out of state: \$45,198

- **Application:** indstate.edu/apply
- **\$45.00 application fee** (nonrefundable). Payable by Visa, MasterCard, check or money order payable to Indiana State University (include SSN or student ID). Applications cannot be evaluated until the fee has been received.
- **Official transcripts** for all institutions attended (undergraduate and graduate) must be sent directly from the school attended to Graduate Admissions. E-transcripts should be sent to admissions@indstate.edu. Indiana State University graduates are not required to submit transcripts.
- **Additional admission materials and requirements.** Please see the specific program requirements below.

Department Requirements

Applications will be considered as they are received.

- "C" or better in all required prerequisite coursework
- Resume or curriculum vitae
- Minimum grade point average (GPA) 3.0 in undergraduate studies
- Contact information for three references (name, phone number, email, address)
- Personal statement
- Verification of CPR certification after admission to program
- Electronic interview
