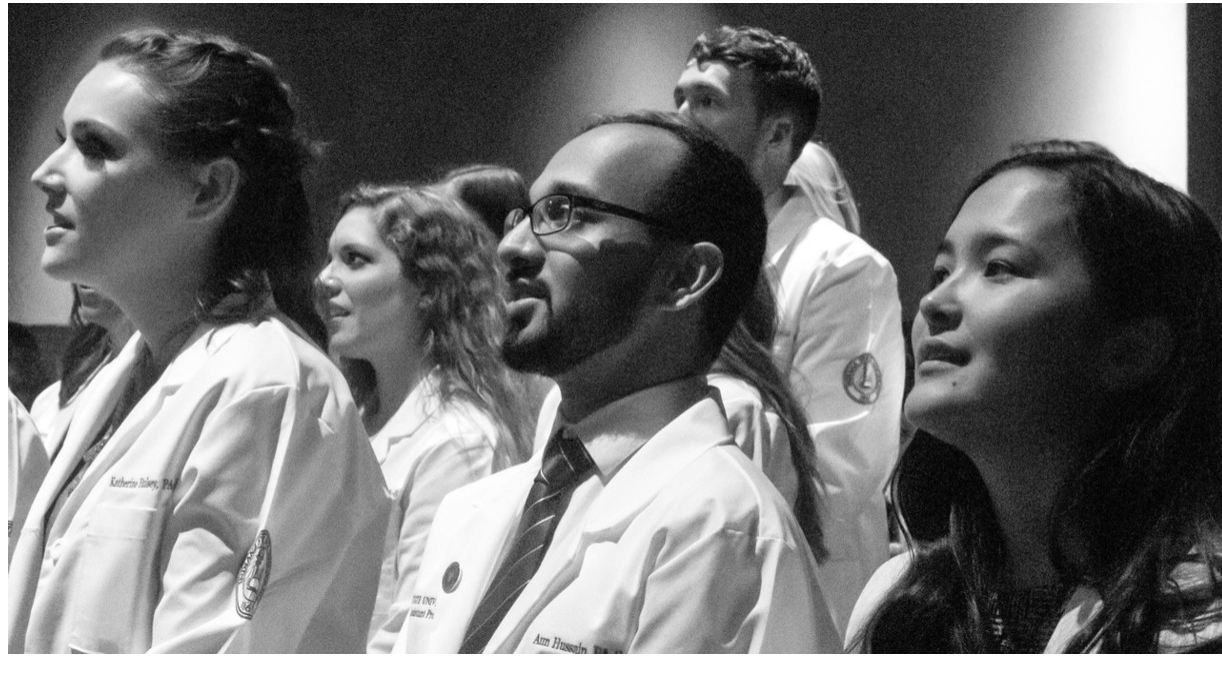
Leah Hester '2020 reflects on her on clinical year...
