

College of Health and Human Services Alumni Excellence Award

Purpose:

The purpose of the Alumni Excellence Award is to recognize an alumnus/alumna, who has demonstrated outstanding professional achievement and endeavors.

Eligibility:

- Any alumni of the College of Health and Human Services (or Nursing, Health, and Human Services or Health and Human Performance; Health, Physical Education and Recreation; Nursing or Department of Social Work or Department of Family and Consumer Sciences or Home Economics) are eligible. For purposes of this award, an alumnus/alumna is any person who was enrolled and completed a degree in any previously named units. Nominees for the Alumni Excellence Award may be current employees of the University.

Criteria:

The nominee should demonstrate:

- Exceptional achievement and significant contributions to their profession or community/society or university.
- Significant contributions, benefiting their community, state or nation.
- Outstanding professional and personal development either through traditional channels or through innovative approaches.

Nomination/Application Procedures:

- Nominations/applications may be submitted by any department, staff member, faculty member, or alumnus/alumna of the College of Health and Human Services.
- Nominations/applications and letters of support should clearly identify and document how the nominee meets each of the criteria. Awards will be based on the materials submitted.

Selection Process:

Nominations are reviewed and the recipient is selected by the College of Health and Human Services Awards Committee.

Award:
