

College of Health and Human Service Outstanding Graduate Student Award – Master’s

Purpose:

The Graduate Student Award recognizes the contributions of graduate students in the College of Health and Human Services at Indiana State University.

Eligibility:

The award is limited to currently enrolled graduate students who have been employed by the CHHS during the current academic year.

Criteria:

The Outstanding Graduate Student will consistently go above and beyond in providing outstanding service to his/her department, program, area, and/or the College. This could be in the areas of teaching, clerical, clinical, research, etc.

Nomination Process:

Nominations may originate from anyone in the College, including self-nominations. Nominations, letters of support, and/or materials should clearly identify how the nominee meets each of the criteria. All materials should be scanned into a single PDF document. Awards will be based on the materials submitted.
