### 2012-2013 Major Achievements

#### **Best Online Nursing Programs of**

**2012.** The online nursing programs were ranked #3 by Super Scholar. <u>http://www.superscholar.org/rankings/o</u> <u>nline/best-nursing-schools/</u>

#### **Doctor of Nursing Practice program** receives NLNAC accreditation for

five years. The Department of Advanced Practice Nursing received a full five year initial accreditation for their DNP program. The program opened in 2010 and graduated their first cohort in May 2012. Currently, the program is seeking approval to expand and offer the DNP to nurse educators and nurse executive leaders. The DNP faculty and four students traveled to Washington, DC, where they engaged in experiential learning regarding health policy on Capitol Hill. The experience is sponsored by the National League for Nursing and is supported by a grant through the Center for Community Engagement.

**Doctorate of Health Sciences Approved.** The Indiana Commission for Higher Education has approved a first-of-its-kind program at Indiana State University to train health care educators. Beginning with the fall 2013 semester, the Department of Applied Health Sciences will offer a Doctorate of Health Sciences degree (D.H.Sc.). The Doctorate of Health Sciences is distinguished by an interdisciplinary approach and will prepare graduates to develop and implement solutions to the complex health issues facing our society. Entry Level Athletic Training (BS).

The Department of Applied Medicine received a 10-year accreditation from Commission on Accreditation of Athletic Training Education (CAATE).

IPE Student Activity. 218 students attended the March 1, 2013, interprofessional (IPE) student activity held in Hulman Memorial Student Union. Students in advanced practice nursing, athletic training, behavioral psychology, billing/coding, dietetics, human development, medicine, nursing, physician assistant science, public health/health administration, radiology and social work participated. The IPE activity grew from the one held in February 2012 to include health professional students in behavioral psychology and billing/coding and added ISU College of Arts and Sciences to the existing IVY Tech State College-Wabash Valley, ISU CNHHS and IU School of Medicine. The planning committee, consisting of Louise Anderson (AHEC), Melanie Castle (IVY Tech medical assisting), Peter Duong (IUSOM) Betsy Frank (BNC), Leamor Kahanov (AMR), Janice Leigh (Psy), Robyn Lugar (SW), Yasenka Peterson (AHS), Linda Walters (BN), Peggy Weber (SW), Julie Will (IVY Tech Dean of Allied Health Sciences) and LouAnn Wiseby (IVY Tech Imaging Studies), met several times during 2012 to review the 2011 data, make revisions based on student input and plan for the March event. Evaluation of the 2013 event and planning for the Friday, February 28, 2014 event are currently underway.

**Massage Therapy.** The Department of Applied Medicine and Rehabilitation started the program and is the only

minor in the United States in massage therapy. In addition, graduates can be certified in 38 states.

Master's Degree Nurse Education Concentration updated the program of study to include current AACN Master's Competencies. In response to the changing climate for nurse educators, the Department of Advanced Practice Nursing has changed the nurse educator curriculum. The change consisted of an addition of 2 credit hours and the development of a new Advanced Assessment course for nurse educators.

**Master of Social Work program approved.** The Master of Social work program was approved by the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE) and is in Candidacy status. The program is scheduled to begin courses Fall semester, 2013.

**NCLEX-RN Pass Rates 2012.** The NCLEX-RN pass rate for all first-time takers in both the campus and distance programs for 2012 was 91.2%. This reflects an overall improvement of 11% from 2011. The first class of accelerated second-degree students from summer 2012 had a pass rate of 100%.

Nonprofit Leadership Alliance National Award. The Nonprofit

Leadership Alliance was awarded the 2013 Sprint Campus Partner of the Year Award – formerly known as the Program of Excellence Award. Such an award signifies the best Nonprofit Leadership Alliance program in the United States. **Occupational Therapy.** The Department of Applied Medicine and Rehabilitation received Accreditation Council for Occupational Therapy Education (ACOTE) developing program status and starts the program Summer 2013 for the Masters of Science in Occupational Therapy (MSOT) degree.

**Physical Therapy and Sports Rehabilitation Clinic.** The outpatient clinic in the Applied Medicine and Rehabilitation has expanded to accommodate the 900% increase in patients over 2 years.

**Physician Assistant Studies**. The Department of Applied Medicine and Rehabilitation graduates the inaugural class May 2013.

### Quality Matters review 2013. The

Baccalaureate Nursing Completion Department is seeking the approval by Quality Matters (QM) of all online nursing courses taken in the LPN to BS and RN to BS tracks. Select faculty will complete training with QM to be beginning reviewers and will do a selfevaluation of their own course and a departmental review. Later, the faculty can become Master reviewers who would/could head teams of reviewers.

#### Sigma Theta Tau International.

Twenty-eight undergraduate nursing students were inducted into Sigma Theta Tau International Honor Society of Nursing in 2012-2013.

# The Department of Advanced Practice Nursing.

The Department of Advanced Practice Nursing prepares advanced practice nurses as expert clinicians in three distinct areas. The program has three Master of Science (MS) nursing concentrations, two post-master's in nursing certificate concentrations, and one Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) program. MS programs foci are in Administration, Education, and Family Nurse Practitioner concentrations. Post-MS certificate programs in Education and Family Nurse Practitioner concentrations are offered. Since 2006, all courses for the graduate programs have been offered through distance learning.

The Department of Advanced Practice Nursing at Indiana State University admitted its first students in 1986, and has maintained continuous accreditation for the Master of Science program by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission, Inc. since 1989. The Doctor of Nursing Practice program recently received its initial five year accreditation.

The mission of the Department of Advanced Practice Nursing is to develop competent, caring nursing professional and productive citizens practicing in advanced nursing roles in clinical care, education, and leadership. This mission is accomplished through a variety of teaching modalities, experiential learning, research and/or the application of research findings, and community and public service.

The Baccalaureate Nursing Program at Indiana State University admitted the first class of students in September 1963. The Department provides a 4year program that is designed for students entering without previous nursing education or licensure and an accelerated track for students with an earned B.S. or Master's Degree in another discipline. The mission of the Department is to develop students who are competent, caring nursing professionals and productive citizens. The mission is accomplished through innovative teaching, experiential learning, research, and community and public service with traditional and nontraditional students in a campus-based setting. The Baccalaureate Degree is recognized as the basic preparation for professional nursing practice, and prepares the graduate as a generalist. Baccalaureate nursing education is foundational for graduate study in nursing. The Program has maintained continuous accreditation by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission, Inc. since 1989 and is accredited by the Indiana State Board of Nursing.
