## Program Stop-Out Form

## You are responsible for dropping all courses in which you are enrolled. Failure to drop courses will result in a failing course grade.

\*Family Nurse Practitioner (FNP) students who have completed APN 644/664 and take more than one semester away may be required to take a one-credit hour independent study course (45 clinical hours) for skills review in the semester prior to resuming the next course in the FNP clinical sequence.
