Reminder your last 10 credits of your undergraduate degree are taken during your first semester in the Master of Athletic Training Program. Therefore, you will only need to complete your foundational studies, major requirements, and a total of 110 Cr by the end of your 3rd year at ISU.

You may be able to use your undergraduate scholarship to pay for your first semester (Summer1) in the MAT if you have at least 1 semester left remaining. You may need to apply through The Branch for permission to use your scholarship for this purpose.
