The Role of Native American Code Talkers During World War II

Dr. Meadows is recognized as the country's foremost authority on the Native American code talkers and is a much sought-after speaker for the Smithsonian Institution. We are fortunate to have him be our special guest speaker for the first session of this two part class. The second session will focus on videos that Dr. Meadows has recommended and a discussion of these videos will be led by Elmer Guerri.

This class will focus on the Native American code talkers and their role in World War II. While many have heard about the "Navajo Code Talkers", less has been written by similar roles played by members of tribes, such as Choctaw, Comanche, Cree, Crow, Hopi, Kiowa, Lakota, and others. There were 400 to 500 code talkers in the U.S. Marine Corps, and Dr. Meadows has interviewed the bulk of the surviving members of that elite group. The code talkers used cryptic words from their native languages and code words from forward observer positions to describe the movement of enemy troops. For instance, to describe submarines, the words for "iron fish" in their Native American languages were used in codified communications with other code talkers.



What Happened to the Mammoths and **Mastodons? The Role of Human Predation Upon Their Extinction**

Dr. Gramly has conducted extensive excavations and research throughout North America and Europe in an effort to better understand how prehistoric human hunters impacted the extinction of Pleistocene megafauna sometime around ten thousand years ago. His most recent publication contains what some describe as revolutionary, "game-changing" insight into the mystery of the disappearance of the large animals. Dr. Gramly will discuss specific examples from North American New World and European Old World sites. His discoveries are especially important in the light of modern anthropogenic (human caused) threats to modern species on the endangered list.
